CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARK ROY MAHONE
17975 ARCHWOOD ST
RESEDA, CA 91335

confirms the right to use the waters of Rogue River, a tributary of Pacific Ocean, for the purpose of the irrigation of 5.55 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit S-11137. The date of priority is December 15, 1933. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.069 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

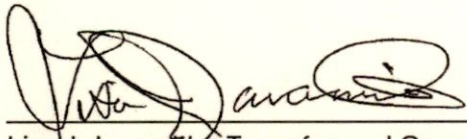

This certificate describes the portion of water right Certificate 45291, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered 7/24/2026, approving Transfer Application T-14396, and along with Confirming Certificate 98409 supersedes Certificate 45291, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
