CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SCHNABELE RANCHES, INC.
37234 IZEE-PAULINA LANE
CANYON CITY, OR 97820

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 1 in the MALHEUR LAKE BASIN for IRRIGATION of 126.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9273. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 21, 1980. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.58 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works shall be equipped with a usable port and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

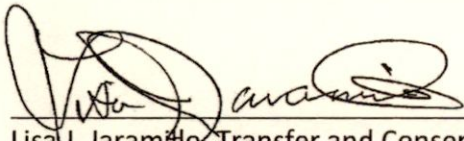
The water user shall maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of groundwater withdrawn.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 82463, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered 7/16/2026, approving Transfer Application T-14144.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
