CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TERRY AND PEGGY LONG PO BOX 145 MITCHELL OR 97750

confirms the right to use the waters of BEAR CREEK, a tributary of BRIDGE CREEK for IRRIGATION of 3.9 ACRES and POND MAINTENANCE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wheeler County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12, at Page 388. The date of priority is PRIOR TO 1889.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) BEFORE JUNE 15 AND 0.12 CFS AFTER JUNE 15, DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON FROM MARCH 1 TO OCTOBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, measured at the point of diversion from the stream and is further limited as follows:

For IRRIGATION, 0.094 CFS BEFORE JUNE 15 AND 0.047 CFS AFTER JUNE 15, DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON FROM MARCH 1 TO OCTOBER 1.

FOR POND MAINTENANCE, 0.146 CFS BEFORE JUNE 15 AND 0.073 CFS AFTER JUNE 15, DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON FROM MARCH 1 TO OCTOBER 1, AND SHALL BE FURTHER LIMITED TO A DIVERSION OF NOT TO EXCEED 24.0 ACRE-FEET DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON FROM MARCH 1 TO OCTOBER 1 OF EACH YEAR.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre of land irrigated before June 15 and ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre after June 15, during the irrigation season from March 1 to October 1 of each year, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable measuring device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

When required by the Department, the water user shall operate and maintain the headgate and measuring device, as needed. The water user or irrigation district shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor the accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen as approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in PLACE OF USE and CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 4, 2003, at Special Order Volume 57, Page 329, approving Transfer Application T-8691, and together with Certificate 79987, supersedes Certificate 78512, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
