CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GENE E. THORNTON
ROSEMARY THORNTON
27840 SEVEN MILE LANE
BROWNSVILLE, OR 97327

has a right to the use of the waters of WELL NO.1 in the CALAPOOIA RIVER basin for the purpose of IRRIGATION.

This right has been perfected under Permit G-6256. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 12, 1974. The right is limited to not more than 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 56982, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 30 2025, approving Transfer Application T-14361.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
