CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SARBANAND ENTERPRISES, LLC  
786 ROAD 188  
DELANO, CA 93215

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER for irrigation of 21.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-45353. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 23, 1980. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-ONE HUNDRED FORTY SECOND (1/142) of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is further limited to an annual volume limitation of 10.55 acre-feet per year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.

This certificate describes water right Certificate 98494, State Record of Water Right Certificates, REDUCED IN RATE by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 20, 2023, approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-132 and correcting order issued JUN 18 2025. This Certificate, together with Certificate 97354 and the conserved water under CW-132, supersedes Certificate 53090.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
