## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) from direct flow and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage. The right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new additional point of diversion (POD 2), together with that diverted at the original point of diversion (POD), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD).

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 9, 2022, at Special Order Volume 122, Page 454, approving Transfer Application T-13620, supercedes Certificate 66173, State record of Water Right Certificates.
