CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of UMPQUA RIVER for INSTREAM USE for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat, and other ecological values.

This right was perfected under Permit S-21281. The date of priority is APRIL 2, 1952.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, measured at the point of diversion, from JULY 11 through OCTOBER 31, further limited to an annual volume of 22.5 ACRE-FEET.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

Umpqua River: From the authorized point of diversion located at approximately River Mile (RM) 102.5:

25 S	7 W	WM	25	SE NE	37	250 FEET NORTH AND 1690 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 25

To the head of tide at Scottsburg, RM 27.2 in the SW 1/4, Section 18, Township 22 South, Range 9 West, WM.


The instream right established by this transfer shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.346, 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 79749, and any related decree.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 135, Page 273, approving Conserved Water Application CW-80. This Certificate together with Certificates 98586 and 98590, and the conserved water under CW-80 supersedes Certificate 79749, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
