CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SAM JOE HENRY II
WILLIAM DEAN HENRY II

UMPQUA, OR 97486

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN for IRRIGATION of 1.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-21281. The date of priority is APRIL 2, 1952. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 79749, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 06 2025, finalizing Allocation of Conserved Water CW-80, recorded at Special Order Volume 135, Page 213. This certificate, together with Certificates 98586 and 98588, and the conserved water under CW-80, supersedes Certificate 79749, State Record of Water Rights Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
