The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for WALLOWA County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5, at Page 206.

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 18.0 ACRES AND STOCK USE

That the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.5 acre-feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st or each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain the headgate as required by the Department, to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- The water user shall maintain the suitable measuring device, in good working order, at each point of diversion (new and existing).
- The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the measuring devices; provided however, where the B. measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall operate and maintain an approved fish screening at the new point of diversion.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 28, 2017, at Special Order Volume 105, Page 704, approving Transfer Application T-12603, supercedes Certificate 47111, State record of Water Right Certificates.
