The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

# NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the point of diversion (POD 3), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD 1), described as follows:

### Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, a totalizing flow meter or another suitable measuring devices as approved by the Director, at each point diversion (new and existing).
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided, however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife operation and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 14, 2021, at Special Order Volume 121, Page 33, approving Transfer Application 13555, supercedes Certificate 15257, State record of Water Right Certificates.
