CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OREGON BERRY PACKING CO.
6000 SW MINTER BRIDGE ROAD
HILLSBORO, OR 97123

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL #5, WELL #6, AND WELL #7 in the Willamette Basin for FOOD PROCESSING OF BERRIES AND FILBERTS.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10711. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 12, 1986. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 90.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE (GPM) FOR FOOD PROCESSING, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

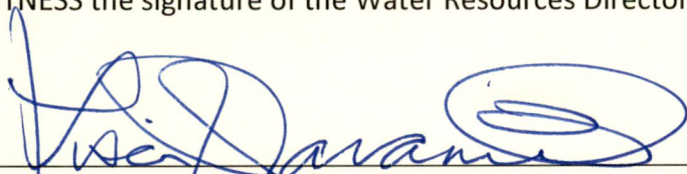
The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 83064, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 19 2025, approving Transfer Application T-13778.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
