confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-10453. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: THREE WELLS IN THE WHITE RIVER BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: DOMESTIC USE FOR 142 HOUSEHOLDS INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE

AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN FOR EACH HOUSEHOLD AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 3.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.19 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.15 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.04 CFS FOR IRRIGATION

# NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation (Well 3), together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation (Well 1 and Well 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (Well 1 and Well 2).

The water user shall equip the additional well with a dedicated 3/4-inch (minimum) water-level measurement tube when the pump is installed; separate from other methods of measuring the water level such as airlines and transducers.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 2, 2014, at Special Order Volume 91, Page 526, approving Transfer Application T-11619, supercedes Certificate 82620, State record of Water Right Certificates.
