CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1.

SOURCE OF WATER: POWELL CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF WILLIAMS CREEK FOR TRACT 2; FOR THE PURPOSES OF IRRIGATION OF 33.5 ACRES IN TRACT NO. 2

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 31.3 ACRES IN TRACT NO. 2 AND NURSERY USE ON 2.2 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.6 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.56 CFS FROM POWELL CREEK FOR TRACT NO. 2, AND FOR NURSERY USE 0.04 CFS AND SHALL BE FURTHER LIMITED TO 17.0 ACRE-Feet DURING THE ENTIRE YEAR

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The amount of water used for NURSERY OPERATIONS is limited to a diversion of 0.04 cubic foot per second per acre and 7.72 acre-feet per acre per year.

For the irrigation of containerized nursery plants, the amount of water diverted is limited to 0.04 cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 7.72 acre-feet per acre per year.

For irrigation of in-ground nursery plants, the amount of water diverted is limited to 0.04 cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 7.72 acre-feet per acre per year.

For the irrigation of any other crop, the amount of water diverted is limited to 0.04 cubic foot per second (its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year. The use of water for irrigation of any other crop shall be limited to 2.2 acres.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, in good working order at each point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE and CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 6, 2019, at Special Order Volume 114, Page 528, approving Transfer Application T-12517, and together with Certificate 94844, supercedes Certificate 81585, State record of Water Right Certificates.
