CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of the waters of A WELL in the FORT ROCK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 5.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under the terms of Permit G-6320. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 20, 1975.

The well is located as follows:

26 S	18 E	WM	7	NE SE	WELL 3 - 610 FEET SOUTH AND 620 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 7

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director in good working order at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (Well 3), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation (Well 4) described as follows:

27 S	17 E	WM	22	SE SW	WELL 4 - 1300 FEET NORTH AND 1310 FEET WEST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 22

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in POINT OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 4, 2022, at Special Order Volume 125, Page 858, approving Transfer Application T-13896, and together with Certificate 96293, supersedes Certificate 81514, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
