CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-9518. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: A SUMP IN THE ILLINOIS RIVER BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 18.8 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 18.8 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.46 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: JANUARY 5, 1981

The sump is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
