CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CORNELL BROTHERS INC.

CHRISTMAS VALLEY, OR 97641

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL within the FORT ROCK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 23.52 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9564. The date of priority is JANUARY 23, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.29 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well) shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:


The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 88736, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 07 2026, approving Transfer Application T-14408.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
