CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER for IRRIGATION of 9.6 ACRES.

This right confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 15, at page 461. The date of priority is 1908.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.15 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs), measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-SIXTY-FOURTH (1/64) of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is further limited to an annual volume limitation of 38.4 acre-feet per year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 25327, State Record of Water Right Certificates, REDUCED IN RATE by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 10, 2025, finalizing Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-146, recorded in Special Order Volume 138, Page 36. This Certificate together with Certificates 98781 and 98782 and the conserved water under CW-146 supersedes Certificate 25327, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
