CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHARLES S. HICKS
CLARNO, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER for IRRIGATION of 10.4 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 15, page 461; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1908.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to Sept. 30; further limited to one acre-foot per acre per calendar month; total of five acre-feet per acre for season, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 25327, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 10 2025, finalizing Allocation of Conserved Water CW-146, recorded at Special Order Volume 138, Page 36. This certificate, together with Certificates 98780 and 98782 and the conserved water under CW-146, supersedes Certificate 25327, State Record of Water Rights Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
