CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 78.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-37751. The date of priority is December 9, 1974.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.22 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (cfs), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-SIXTY-FOURTH (1/64) of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is further limited to an annual volume limitation of 312.4 acre-feet per year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 55361, State Record of Water Right Certificates, REDUCED IN RATE by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 10, 2025, finalizing Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-146, recorded in Special Order Volume 138, Page 310. This Certificate together with Certificates 98784 and 98785 and the conserved water under CW-146 supersedes Certificate 55361, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
