CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BILLY M. CROSS

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 17.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-37751 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 9, 1974. The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.34 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 55361, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 10 2025, finalizing Allocation of Conserved Water CW-146, recorded at Special Order Volume 138, Page 310. This certificate, together with Certificates 98783 and 98785 and the conserved water under CW-146, supersedes Certificate 55361, State Record of Water Rights Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
