CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BILL CROSS

confirms the right to use the waters of THE JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of THE COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATING 37.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-49236. The date of priority is December 28, 1984. The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.94 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 5.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 67096, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 10 2025, finalizing Allocation of Conserved Water CW-146, recorded at Special Order Volume 138, Page 36. This certificate, together with Certificates 98786 and 98788 and the conserved water under CW-146, supersedes Certificate 67096, State Record of Water Rights Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
