CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-5528. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TROUT CREEK AND SPRINGS, A TRIBUTARY OF WALLOWA RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 18.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.225 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: JULY 17, 1922

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed 0.225 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as maybe be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurements conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, a totalizing flow meter, or another measuring device as approved by the Director, at each point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters and measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 31, 2018, at Special Order Volume 108, Page 1004, approving Transfer Application 12654, supercedes Certificate 3821, State record of Water Right Certificates.
