## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-20251. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of appropriation from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: A SLOUGH WHICH IS A CHANNEL OF WILLAMETTE RIVER A TRIBUTARY OF WILLAMETTE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.142 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: MARCH 12, 1951

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season or each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (POA 1 and POA 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD 1) described as follows:

The wells from which the water is taken under this right shall be constructed so that the use of the wells will affect the surface water source similar to the use of the original point of diversion.

The use of water under this right shall be subject to regulation consistent with the other water rights from the use surface water source and to all other applicable conditions and restrictions that existed at the original point of diversion.

The use of water under this right shall be subject to regulations consistent with other water rights from surface water source and to all other applicable conditions and restrictions that existed at the original point of diversion.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, in good working order at each point of appropriation.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

All applicable restrictions that existed at the original point of diversion shall apply to the wells.

The right to the use of the water for purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION FROM SURFACE WATER TO GROUND WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 18, 2021, at Special Order Volume 118, Page 587, approving Transfer Application T-13350, and together with Certificate 95393, supercedes Certificate 21006, State record of Water Right Certificates.
