confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-10718. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: FOUR WELLS IN THE GOOSE AND SUMMER LAKE BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 85.6 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.072 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: JANUARY 22, 1987

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriations (Wells 4, 5, and A), together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation (Well 8), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (Well 8).

The well shall be maintained in accordance with General Standards for Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The water user shall install and maintain, a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the instantaneous and totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, in good working order at each point of appropriation, (new and existing).
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring device(s); provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE and ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 4, 2021, at Special Order Volume 120, Page 420, approving Transfer Application T-13122, and together with Certificate 95681, supercedes Certificate 86164, State record of Water Right Certificates.
