CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1.

SOURCE OF WATER: THE APPLGATE RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF THE ROGUE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATING 3.2 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: 1876

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

40 S	3 W	WM	5	SW SW	COMSTOCK DITCH - 1000 FEET NORTH AND 1190 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 5

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain fish screening or fish by-pass device, at the new point of diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 1, 2004, at Special Order Volume 61, Page 317, approving Transfer Application T-8589, and together with Certificate 81011, supercedes Certificate 79835, State record of Water Right Certificates.
