CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EAGLE CREEK NORTHWEST LLC
PO BOX 592
YAKIMA, WA 98907

confirms the right to use the waters of the SMALLMAN CREEK, a tributary of the NORTH SANTIAM RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 44.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-51213. The date of priority is JUNE 26, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.55 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND for supplemental irrigation, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

10 S	2 W	WM	10	NE NW	5300 FEET NORTH AND 1390 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 10

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 95252, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered 5/19/2026, approving Transfer Application T-13015.


The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

Failure to comply with any provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use described herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
