CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON  
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH FORK of LITTLE BUTTE CREEK for INSTREAM USE for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat, and other ecological values.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 498; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from July 1, 1907.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.079 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, measured at the head of the ditch or the point where the same leaves the natural stream, from APRIL 1ST TO OCTOBER 1<sup>ST</sup> of each year, further limited to an annual volume of 27.5056 ACRE-FEET.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the authorized point of diversion at approximately River Mile (RM) 24.3:

To: the mouth of South Fork Little Butte Creek, at the confluence with Little Butte Creek

Water rights upstream of the original point of diversion shall not be subject to regulation for flows in excess of the quantities to which this instream water right is entitled at the original point of diversion.


The amount of water to which this right is entitled shall not exceed the quantity of water legally available at the original point of diversion.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 17226, and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 138, Page 837, approving Conserved Water Application CW-148. This Certificate together with Certificate 98983, Certificate 98985, and the conserved water under CW-148 supersedes Certificate 17226, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
