CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TUMALO TOWN DISTRICT IMPROVEMENT COMPANY
64682 COOK AVE #54
BEND, OR 97701

confirms the right to use the waters of the DESCHUTES RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 3.98 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permits S-19750 and S-21807. The dates of priority are AUGUST 3, 1950 and SEPTEMBER 30, 1952. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.087 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.02 CFS under the 1950 priority and 0.067 CFS under the 1952 priority, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


This certificate confirms a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 27, 2024, and recorded at Volume 133, Pages 121-124, approving Transfer Application T-14071. In addition, this Certificate includes the portion of the originating water right Certificate 76465, NOT modified by the provisions of Transfer Application T-14071.

This certificate supersedes Certificate 76465. The issuance of this superseding certificate confirms only the status of the portion of the water right affected by the water right action in Transfer Application T-14071. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm any other portion of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The use described herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
