CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of COW CREEK, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 25.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-5364. The date of priority is JANUARY 9, 1922. The right is limited to not more than 0.31 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source

The points of diversion are located as follows:

| 32 S | 6 W | WM | 25 | SW NE | 2 | NEW ADDITIONAL POD - 370 FEET NORTH AND 1965 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 25 |

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director in good working order at the new point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion, described as follows

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 14, 2014, at Special Order Volume 93, Page 97, approving Transfer Application T-11627, and together with Certificate 89451, supersedes Certificate 58504, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
