CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS, a tributary of PUDDING RIVER (WILLAMETTE RIVER), for IRRIGATION of 24.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-875. The date of priority is JUNE 6, 1958. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.195 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of appropriation are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation (Well A), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (Well F), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (Well F).

The new well (Well A) shall be constructed to produce only from the alluvial aquifer at elevations below 77 feet above mean sea level (AMSL) and shall be continuously cased and continuously sealed to a depth immediately above the open interval.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 7, 2024, at Special Order Volume 133, Page 155, and modified entered DECEMBER 6, 2024, at Special Order Volume 133, Page 473, approving Transfer Application T-13384, and together with Certificate 99029, supersedes Certificate 29402, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
