CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL and ONE SUMP in the BETHEL CREEK BASIN for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS on 9.92 ACRES and IRRIGATION of 2.82 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11356. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 29, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.07 CFS FROM THE WELL AND UP TO 0.04 CFS FROM THE SUMP, FURTHER LIMITED TO 0.035 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well and sump.

The points of appropriation are located as follows:

The amount of water diverted for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS, together with amounts secured under any other rights existing for the same lands, is limited as follows: For temperature control, 0.15 cubic foot per second (cfs) per acre. For flood harvesting or pest control, 0.05 cfs per acre. For irrigation of cranberries, ONE-FORTIETH of one cfs and 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. For the irrigation of any other crop, ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cfs and 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director in good working order at each new point of appropriation.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring devices; provided however, where the meter or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (SUMP 2) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (WELL 1 AND SUMP 1), described as follows:

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water confirmed herein shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in POINT OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 26, 2016, at Special Order Volume 100, Page 337, approving Transfer Application T-12102, and together with Certificate 91424, supersedes Certificate 83305, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
