CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

T. W. JONES
MERRILL, OR 97633

confirms the right to use the waters of Five Wells, a tributary of Klamath Lake for irrigation of 585.6 acres and supplemental irrigation of 45.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit U-216. The date of priority is APRIL 23, 1947. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 7.9 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 7.9 c.f.s., provided further that the amount of water allowed herein. Together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, The Well shall be cased so as to prevent loss of underground water. And shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the appropriate state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

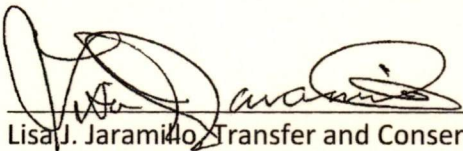
