confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-2243. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: YAMSAY #2 WELL AND BAR Y #1 WELL, TRIBUTARIES OF COW CREEK (WILLIAMSON RIVER)

PURPOSE OR USE: SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 753.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 9.41 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, FURTHER LIMITED TO 5.84 CFS FROM BAR Y #1 WELL

DATE OF PRIORITY: SEPTEMBER 4, 1962

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation (BAR Y #1 (KLAM 59411)), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation (YAMSAY #2 (KLAM 50590)).

If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed on this right, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interferences.

The water user shall ensure that the well has been assigned an OWRD Well Identification Number (Well ID Tag), which shall be permanently attached to the well. The Well ID shall be used as reference in any correspondence regarding the well, including any reports of water use, water level, or pump test data.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, a totalizing flow meter or with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The well (KLAM 50590) shall be configured to allow a strictly clean water (no oil) static water level measurements with an electric-tape. That can include measurement access via an unobstructed vertical discharge pipe that allows the groundwater level to fluctuate freely within the discharge pipe (no valve, etc.). Otherwise, a dedicated measuring tube must be installed prior to use. The tube must be unobstructed, have a diameter of ¾ inch (0.75 inch) or greater and pursuant to figure 200-5 in OAR 690-200.

The well (KLAM 59411) shall have a dedicate measuring tube that must be maintained and operational. The tube must be unobstructed, have a diameter of ¾ inch (0.75 inch) or greater and pursuant to figure 200-5 in OAR 690-200.

The right to the use of the water for the purpose aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 6, 2015, at Special Order Volume 95, Page 436, approving Transfer Application T-11922, and together with Certificate 90001, supercedes Certificate 34992, State record of Water Right Certificates.
