The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The water user shall maintain a staff gage that measures the entire range and stage between full reservoir level and dead pool in the reservoir. The staff gage shall be United States Geological Survey style porcelain enamel iron staff gage style A, C, E, or I.

The minimum pool of 9.0 acre feet shall be left in the reservoir at all times.

The water user shall not operate or maintain any dam or artificial obstruction to fish passage in the channel of the subject stream unless a fishway is provided as required by Oregon Fish and Wildlife (ODFW).

The water user shall maintain and operate the fishway approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of fully functional conduit/gate assembly having a minimum diameter of 8 inches.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to store water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
