CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-2983. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: THREE WELLS, WITHIN THE LITTLE PUDDING RIVER BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 207.9 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.46 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: JULY 21, 1965

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation (Well 5), together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation (Well 1 and Well 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (Well 1 and Well 2).

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The water user shall operate and maintain the meter in working order.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 31, 2019, at Special Order Volume 112, Page 527, approving Transfer Application T-12895, supercedes Certificate 85733, State record of Water Right Certificates.
