PURPOSE OR USE: MUNICIPAL

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.28 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS); FURTHER LIMITED TO 0.28 CFS FROM EACH WELL 1 AND WELL 10, AND 0.07 CFS FROM WELL 8, IN ANY COMBINATION NOT TO EXCEED 0.28 CFS IN TOTAL

Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
