CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WOLF RUN WATER USERS ASSOCIATION
ROUTE 1 BOX 192
DUFUR, OR 97021

confirms the right to use the waters of the TAMARACK CREEK, SPRINGS and GULCH, and EIGHTMILE CREEK, tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 108.1 ACRES, DOMESTIC, and STOCK USE.

This right was perfected under Permits 92 and 93. The date of priority is MAY 3, 1909. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.422 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, being 1.351 CFS for irrigation and 0.071 CFS for Domestic and stock use, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows: WOLF RUN DITCH.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

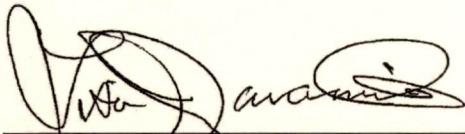
