confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-4947. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: THREE WELLS, A TRIBUTARY OF UMATILLA RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: INDUSTRIAL (FOOD PROCESSING)

MAXIMUM RATE/DUTY: 2.66 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, FROM EITHER WELL OR IN ANY COMBINATION NOT TO TOTAL MORE THAN 2.66 CFS INSTANTANEOUS AND IS FURTHER RESTRICTED TO A MAXIMUM TOTAL ANNUAL DUTY OF 1922.38 ACRE-FEET PER YEAR.

DATE OF PRIORITY: JANUARY 21, 1972

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The well (Martin Well No. 1) has been constructed to a depth of 110 feet and is subject to the terms and conditions of an Order entered on April 2, 1976 pertaining to the Ordinance Gravel Critical Ground Water Area.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (Well No. 2 and Well No. 3), together with that diverted at the old point (Martin Well No. 1) of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation (Martin Well No. 1).

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, a totalizing flow meter, or another suitable device as approved by the Director, at each point of appropriation.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided, however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECT A SCRIVENER'S ERROR AND CORRECTLY IDENTIFY THE NUMBER OF WELLS, AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 98955.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described; and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 28, 2019, at Special Order Volume 113, Page 195, approving Transfer Application T-12820, which supersedes Certificate 43933, State record of Water Right Certificates.
