CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TONY CHETWOOD
47935 FISH LAKE RD
HALFWAY, OR 97834

confirms the right to use the waters of MAIN PINE CREEK, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 40.0 ACRES of LAND and DOMESTIC USE.

This right was perfected under Permit E-69. The date of priority is MAY 13, 1910. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.53 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Prior to October 1, 2027, the water user shall install an approved fish screen at the new point of diversion and shall provide to the OWRD a written statement from Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) that the installed screen meets the state's criteria, or that ODFW has determined a screen is not necessary.

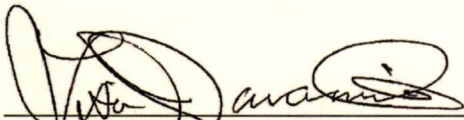
The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm an HISTORIC CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered 8/28/2026, approving Transfer Application T-14512, and, together with remaining right Certificate 99262, supersedes Certificate 853, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use described.
