CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-6183. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: UMATILLA RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF COLUMBIA RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 1.6 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: FEBRUARY 2, 1924

The shallow well is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
3 N	29 E	WM	21	SW NE	1367 FEET SOUTH AND 1390 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 21

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

3 N	29 E	WM	21	NW NE	1.6

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter, or other suitable measuring device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

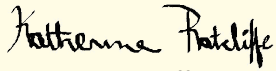
NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The use confirmed herein may be made only as times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 30, 2005, at Special Order Volume 66, Page 827, approving Transfer Application T-7919, supercedes Certificate 75453, State record of Water Right Certificates.
