CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of UMATILLA RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 37.1 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is December 15, 1904.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.46 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION DESCRIBED AS WILSON DITCH), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The shallow well is located as follows:

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meters or other suitable measuring device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.

The water user shall report total flow figures when requested by the Department. The Watermaster may monitor accuracy of the measuring devices, as needed.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 30, 2005, at Special Order Volume 66, Page 827, approving Transfer Application T-7919, and together with Certificate 81586, supercedes Certificate 80979, State record of Water Right Certificates.
