CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-4330. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: ONE WELL IN CROW CAMP CREEK BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 34.4 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.215 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: SEPTEMBER 23, 1968

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director at each point of appropriation (new and existing) in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interference.

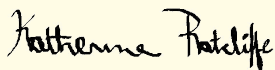
The water user shall ensure that the well has been assigned an OWRD Well Identification Number (Well ID tag), which shall be permanently attached to the well. The Well ID shall be used as a reference in any correspondence regarding the well, including any reports of water use, water level, or pump test data.

Dedicated Measuring Tube: Wells with pumps shall be equipped with a minimum $\frac{3}{4}$ -inch diameter, unobstructed, dedicated measuring tube pursuant to figure 200-5 in OAR 690-200.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 2, 2021, at Special Order Volume 121, Page 916, approving Transfer Application T-13346, and together with Certificate 95500, supercedes Certificate 94575, State record of Water Right Certificates.
