CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This is to Certify, That** Pearl Obenchain McNair, individually and as guardian of her minor children, Lee Arlet Hixon and Wilbur Gordon Hixon, of Beatty, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of North Fork of Sprague River, and Five Mile Creek,

for the purpose of Irrigation of 255.2 acres, and stock water,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Klamath County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 10, at page 236; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1878;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre, prior to June 15th, and one-eightieth of a cubic foot per second per acre after June 15th, with a total limitation of three acre feet per acre from March 1st to October 1st of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

20 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 20 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 36.8 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 30 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 Section 7,  
 30 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 39.2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 39.4 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 39.8 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 Section 18,  
 Township 36 South, Range 14 East, W.M.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
