Dear Sir:

We wish to refer to your letter of Aug. 30, 1963, with reference to final proof in connection with our Permit number 25807.

In accordance with your request, we have made a complete survey of the irrigated area, and are attaching hereto, the original map on which there is outlined in red, the irrigated area as determined by the survey. We are also attaching hereto, two copies of the field notes of the traverse of the area, and two copies of the closure.

It will be noted that the area included within AP 8 to 9 to 10 to 11 appears to extend into the river. However, we wish to explain that this area formerly was a slough and island which in the course of time has filled in and the area has become attached to the adjoining land by accretion.

We trust that the attached documents will prove sufficient to permit the issuance of the final certificate.
