

CERTIFICATE OF SURVEYOR

Irving, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the lands delineated on the annexed plot, of which the following is a true and correct description: Beginning at a 2"x36" Galv. Iron Pipe, 2' above ground, and driven to solid rock, from which pipe the Exterior Ell Corner on the East boundary of the Jos. Cox D.L.C. N^o 44, T27S, R4W, W.M. bears N69°12'40"E 1516 1/2'; Thence S35°16'E 10' to a point on the North boundary of Buckhorn Road; Thence following said boundary S53°57'30"W 325 1/2 ft. to the beginning of a curve to the right having a radius of 210' and a central angle of 43°14'30"; Thence along said curve 158 1/2 ft. to the end thereof; Thence N83°48'W 995 1/2 ft. and N85°34'W 384 3/8 ft. to the intersection of said North boundary with the East boundary of Strader Road; Thence N2°55'W 698 45 ft. along said East boundary; Thence S78°28'E 10' to an axle, and 182 1/2 ft. to an axle; Thence S47°55'40"E 263 1/2 ft. to an axle; Thence S79°16'40"E 711 1/2 ft. to a 1/2" I.P., and 310 1/2 ft. to a 1/2" I.P., and 337 1/2 ft. to a 1/2" I.P.; Thence S35°16'E 156 1/2 ft. to the point of beginning; containing 21 1/2 Acres, more or less in Sections 20, and 21, T27S, R4W, W.M., Douglas County, Oregon.
