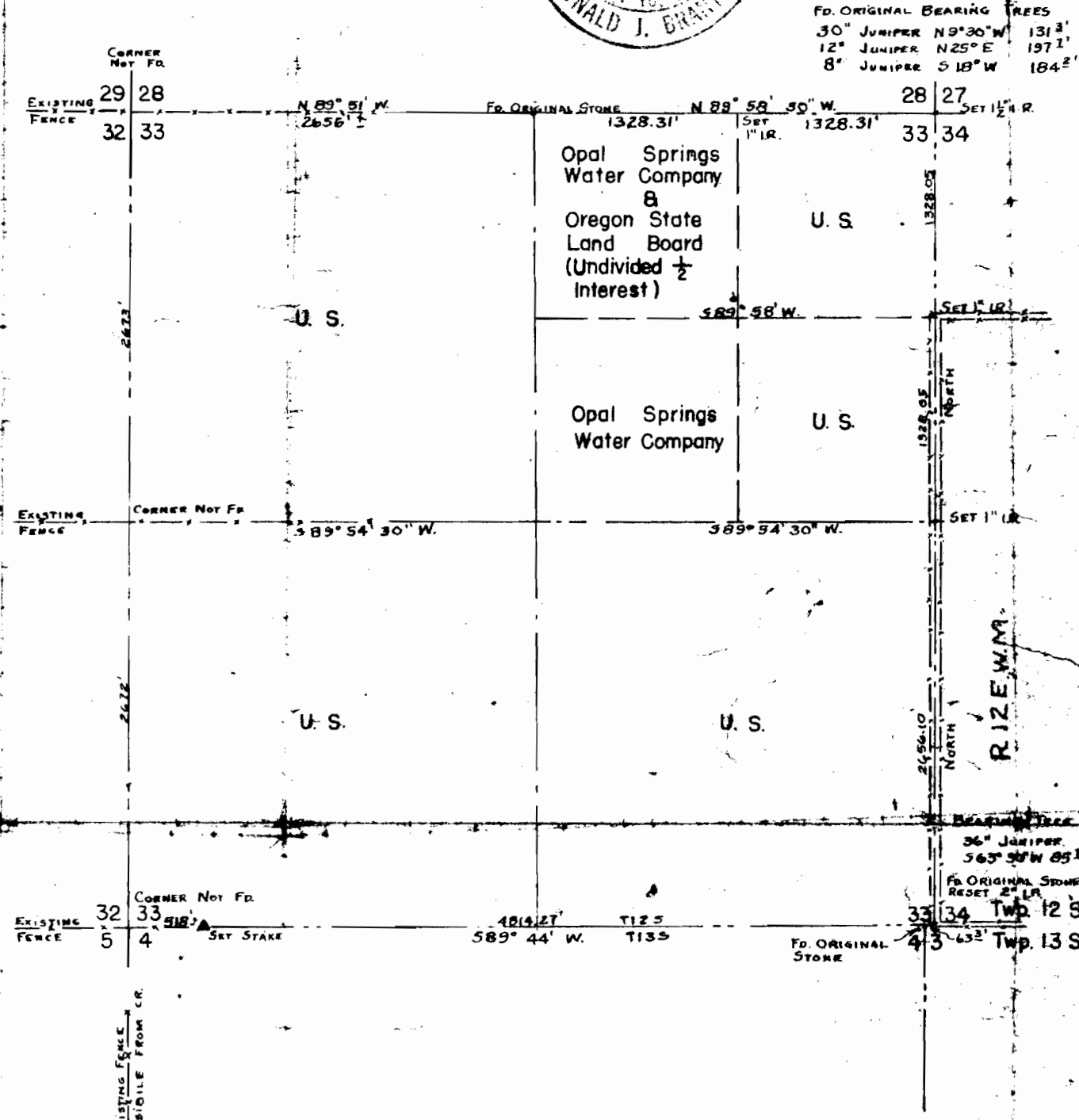
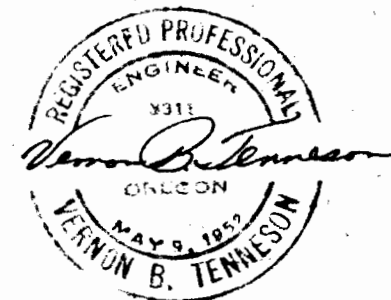


① ENGINEER'S CERTIFICATE:

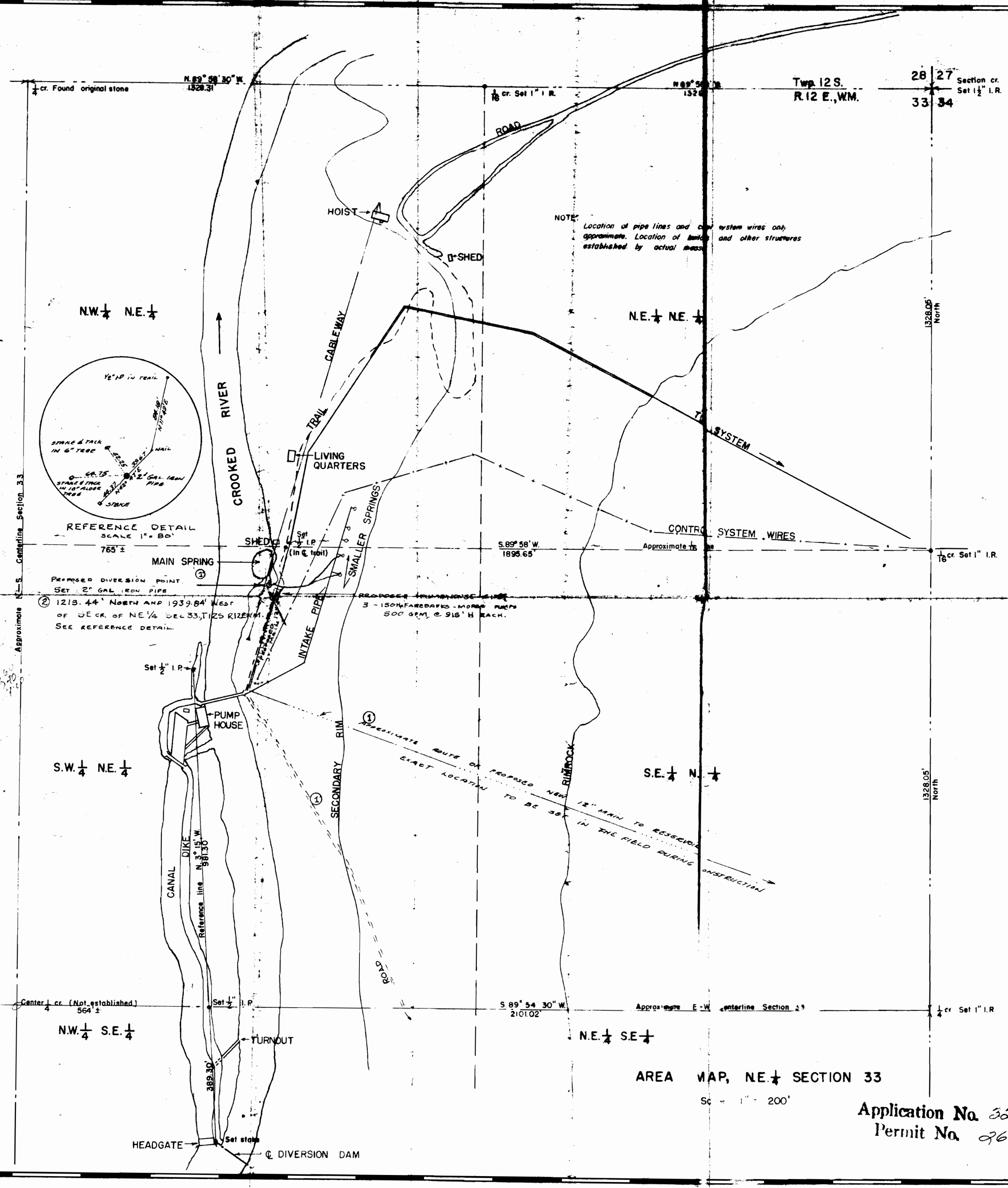

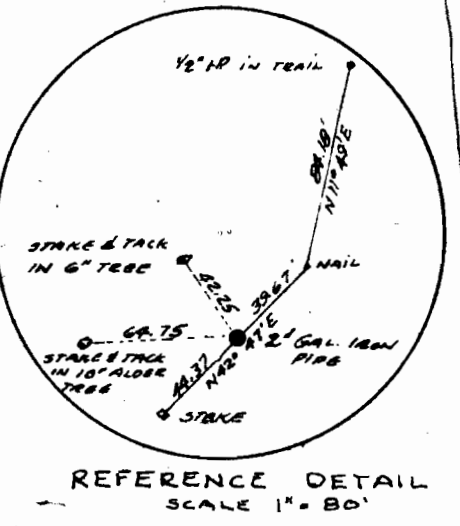
