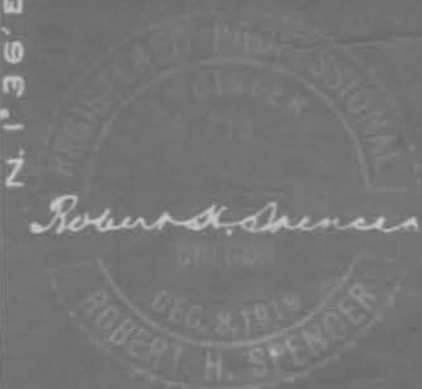

SURVEYORS CERTIFICATE

STATE OF OREGON S.S.
COUNTY OF TILLAMOOK

I, Robert H. Spencer, being first duly sworn, depose and say, that I surveyed the land described in the annexed Second Amended Plat of GARIBALDI PARK, situated in the North half of Section Twenty-one and the South half of Section Sixteen, Township One North and Range Ten West, W.M., and that I set appropriate monuments at each corner thereof; that I established an INITIAL POINT, which point is described as follows: beginning at the section corner common to Sections 15-16-21&22, Township One North, Range Ten West, W.M., thence N. 88° 03' W. 1688.4 feet where I set a galvanized iron pipe 2 1/2 inches in diameter and 36 inches long driven six inches below the surface of the ground.



That the correct description of said Second Amended Plat of GARIBALDI PARK is as follows: beginning at the said INITIAL POINT, thence N. 88° 24' West 1320 feet, thence S. 1° 36' W. 1320 feet, thence S. 88° 24' E. 1320 feet, thence N. 1° 36' E. 1320 feet to place of beginning.
