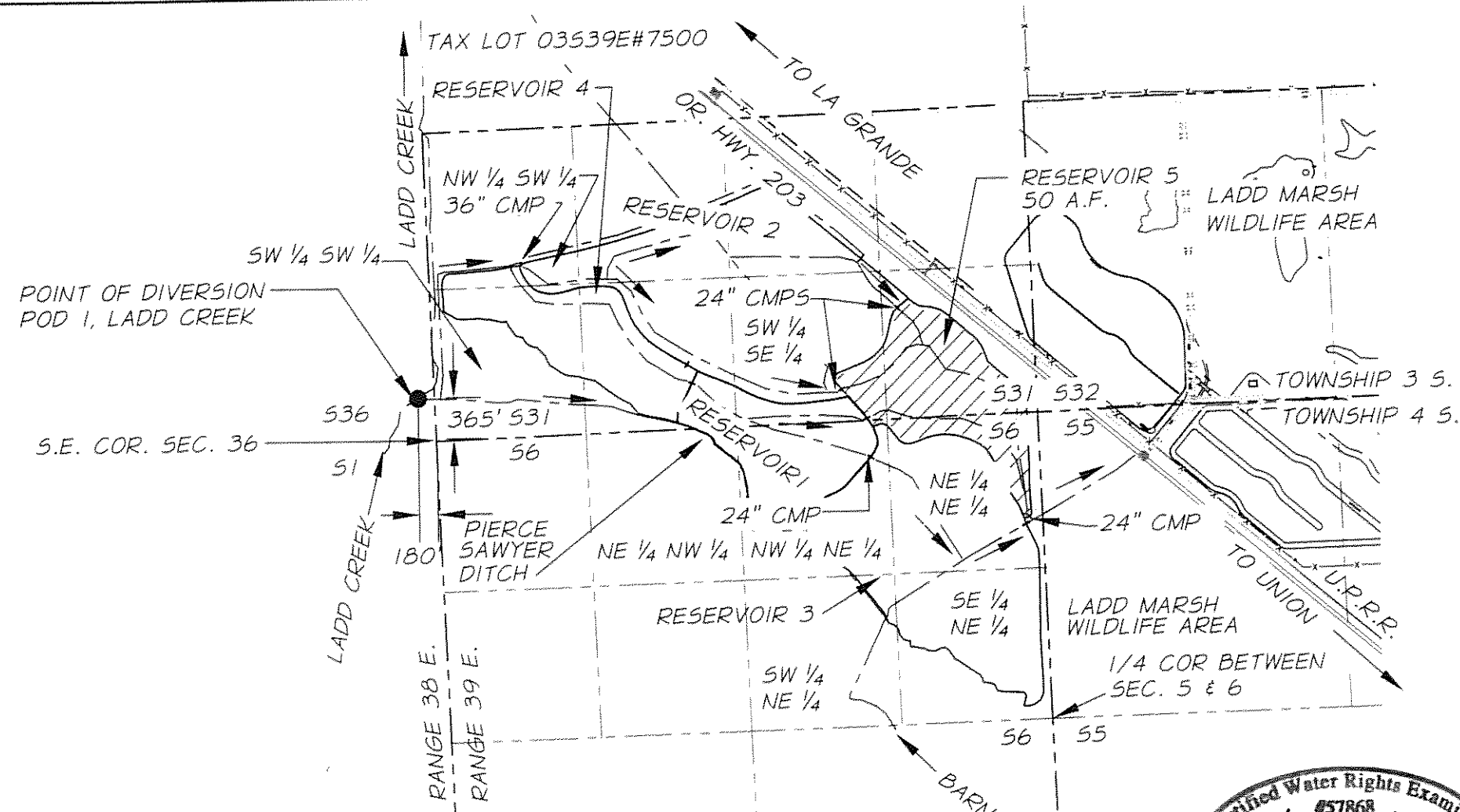

 1. RESERVOIR 5 HAS AN AVERAGE DAM HEIGHT OF 3 FEET AND COVERS AN AREA OF 32 ACRES. THE RESERVOIR CAN HOLD A MAXIMUM STORAGE VOLUME OF WATER OF 50 ACRE FEET, WHEN THE WATER IS AN AVERAGE OF 1.5 FEET DEEP.
