

OF CLAIMANT OF RIGHT TO APPROPRIATE GROUND WATER

(Under Chapter 703, Oregon Laws 1955.)

TO THE STATE ENGINEER OF OREGON:

I, S. E. Trent of 539 Pennsylvania Ave., Medford County of Jackson

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a certificate of registration as evidence of a right to appropriate ground water.

1. Source from which water is withdrawn is pump well (Flowing well, pump well, infiltration trench, or tunnel)

2. Location is: approximately 1/8 mile southwest of Talent, Oregon (Approximate distance and direction from nearest city or town)

and is more particularly described as follows:

(a) 1535 feet South and 111 feet East from the NW corner of Section 26 (Give distance and bearing to corner of section or other legal subdivision)

being within NW 1/4 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 26, Twp. 38 S., Rge. 1 W. (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

or (b) within limits of recorded platted property, town or city:

in Lot, Block of (Name of plat or addition)

County of (If within city or town, give name)

3. Construction Work was begun on May 1911 (Date); was completed on July 1911 (Date)

and the ground water claimed was first used for the purposes set out below on July 1911 (Date)

since which time the water has been used intermittently (Continuously or Intermittently)

from July 1911 (Date) to 1956 (Date)

4. Quantity of water claimed and used is 100 gallons per minute; 4.5 acre feet per year.

5. Purpose or Purposes for which water is used irrigation (Domestic, irrigation, municipal, manufacturing, industrial, etc.)

6. Description of Well: Depth 20 feet. Type dug (Dug or drilled)

diameter 6 feet square. Elevation of ground at well site 1630 feet, mean sea level. (As near as known)
