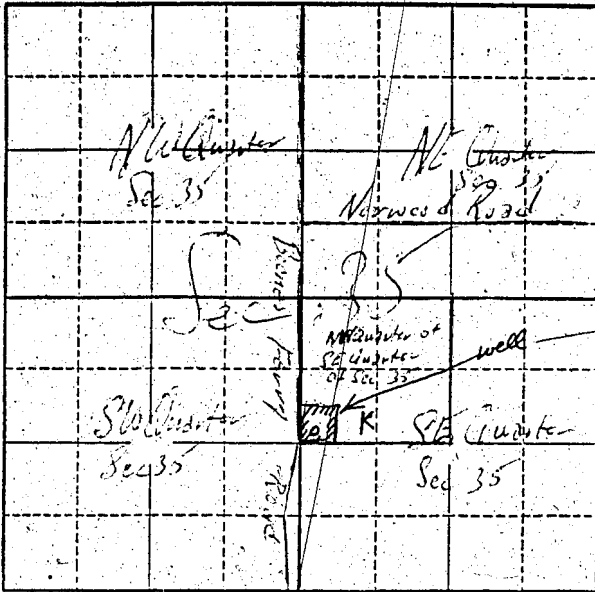




Section 35
